



SOLIDAR is a European network of NGOs and labour movement organisations working towards all people living in dignity. SOLIDAR promotes the principles of solidarity, equality and social justice in the areas of social affairs, international cooperation and education.

With 47 member organisations active in 90 countries worldwide, SOLIDAR works in cooperation with its members, trade unions, political institutions and civil society actors. SOLIDAR aims to influence policy at EU and international level and link members together to learn from each other and carry out projects.

The core areas of SOLIDAR are:

- **Social Affairs:** SOLIDAR calls for access to high-quality, accessible, affordable social care for all members of society; a balanced approach to economic, employment and social policy; social inclusion and freedom from discrimination; and the active involvement of civil society in policy-making.
- **International Cooperation:** SOLIDAR focuses on North-South cooperation, international trade, aid, debt, migration and integration. SOLIDAR plays a coordinating role in 'cooperation in the field' humanitarian aid projects in Sri Lanka, India, Iraq, the Balkans and Palestine.
 - ◇ **Decent Work Decent Life campaign:** SOLIDAR promotes decent work and the promotion and inclusion of the concept in European and international trade agreements and employment policies.
 - ◇ **Global Network project:** A world-wide alliance of trade unions and civil society organisations working together for a fair globalisation.
- **Education:** SOLIDAR emphasises lifelong learning and the right to education for all members of society as well as the promotion of development issues through development education activities.
